• Western Dubuque Lions Club (Chartered in November of 2019.) has had two activities. Their charter night banquet raised \$1453.00. They also held a food drive and donated \$100 to the Western Dubuque school pantry.

- Evansdale/Elk Run Lions club held a food collection at Fareway and collected \$199.42 in donations.
- Waterloo Club donated \$500 to the Northeast Iowa Food Bank.
- Independence Lions club will be celebrating 90 years in August. They also have challenged each member to give \$50.00 to the club to donate to local community needs.
- **Denver Lions Club** donated \$250.00 each to both Helping Hands Food Pantry in Sumner/Oran and Waverly. They provided service help to several Denver, Ia. projects and mobilized a group to sew face masks. Their on-line talent show is going all the time and you can see it on the Denver Lions Facebook account. Denver has established a Leo club during this pandemic and the members are having fun staying in touch through their cell phones. The LEO club has created a unique common bond. The LEOS have created a local PSA regarding the need to stay at home.
- Cedar Falls Club held a highway clean up. Members were assigned specific areas to clean up and leave the bags behind. 47 members participated. The Cedar Falls Lions Diabetes garden has been planted and if we get some warm weather the vegetables will grow nicely. The Cedar Falls Club has a weekly newsletter that has a different theme each week and members are asked to contribute to the theme. It also shares any local club news and needs.

*The USA/CANADA forum in Louisville, KY is still on. Reservations to ride the bus are being taken by sending your reservation and check to Richard Congdon. **The early bus registration deadline has been moved back to May 31.** Don't forget that you still need to register separately for the forum directly with the forum registrar. The bus will leave on Wednesday morning September 16 from the Waterloo Hawkeye Stages bus depot 3315 Titan Trail Waterloo, Iowa. You can leave your car at this location as there is plenty of room. The bus will leave at 6 am and should arrive in Louisville around 5 pm. There are some in the district that have registered for the forum but not the bus. We encourage you to use the bus. IOWA LIONS FOUNDATION: The Lions Clubs of Iowa support our state's causes: Iowa Lions Eye bank, KidsSight, Iowa Lions Hearing and Cochlear Implant Center, Iowa Hearing Aids Bank, Iowa School for the Blind, and Iowa School for the Deaf. Each district is assigned a dollar goal. It is our district position that all clubs in our district make some kind of contribution. Our District's goal is \$36,000.00. 
When you post your officers, be sure you include complete contact information. **WE NEED YOUR PHONE NUMBERS AND EMAIL ADDRESS**.
